**Driving Instructions to Seattle Childrens' Hospital
4800 Sand Point Way N.E., Seattle, WA 98105**

- Park in the Ocean Lot at the top of the hill, Ocean 7
- Check in at Security desk and get a badge
- Take the Whale Elevators to Level 5
- Meeting Room is OA.5.340, halfway down the 1st hallway on the left as you get off the elevator

From the north or south on I-5:

- Take I-5 north or south to exit #169, NE 45th Street. Turn east onto NE 45th Street.
- Go 1.5 miles, passing the University of Washington.
- At the bottom of the hill, turn left at the stoplight and continue on NE 45th Street.
- NE 45th Street will bear left, becoming Sand Point Way NE.
- Turn right at the stoplight onto Children's campus. Go to the Lot 1 Visitor parking.

From Eastside (Hwy 520):

- Take 520 west over the Evergreen Point Bridge.
- Take the Montlake Exit (north) for 1.1 miles
- Bear right onto 45th Street, which becomes Sand Point Way NE
- Turn right at the stoplight onto Children's campus. Go to the Lot 1 Visitor parking
