Driving Instructions:

From Interstate 405 southbound

- Take **Exit 13B** for N.E. 8th Street East/West.
- Turn right onto westbound N.E. 8th Street.
- Turn right onto 112th Avenue N.E.
- Turn right onto N.E. 10th Street, driving over I-405.
- Turn right into the medical center.

From Interstate 405 northbound

- Take **Exit 13A** for N.E. 4th Street.
- Turn right onto N.E. 4th Street.
- Turn left onto 116th Avenue N.E.
- Turn left onto N.E. 10th Street.
- Turn left into the medical center.
